Andrea Pruneau Honored with 2024 BX Cornerstone Award

Andrea Pruneau, past president of the BX Board of Directors, has been named the 70th recipient of the Builders Exchange Cornerstone Award.

Pruneau, senior project manager at Barton Malow Builders, was selected based on her leadership contributions to the community, the industry and the Exchange. Considered to be the highest honor presented in the central Ohio construction industry, the Cornerstone Award has been given annually since 1954. Pruneau becomes the third female in the history of the award to receive this honor, joining Cathy Blackford (2016) and Kathy Gatterdam (2022).

to the organization, including a decade on the board of directors and a term as president in 2005. Her involvement extended to serving on the Builders Exchange Foundation board of directors as well.

Her involvement at the Exchange includes participation on the Board Nominating Committee, Cornerstone Review Committee, member of the SCGC Steering Committee, a Scholarship Trustee and Craftsmanship and Safety Awards judge. Pruneau has also served as a panelist for BX Young Professionals Group events and has been an active volunteer for the Student Outreach Program since its inception.

Outside her BX involvement, Pruneau's impact on the future of the industry can be seen through her participation in the OSU CSM Industry Advisory Council and as an instructor for the OSU CSM program. She has chaired, or served in various capacities, for several local charities and organizations including Women Inspire Construction, Clintonville Area Commission Zoning and Variance Committee, International Facility Management Association, COGENCE Alliance and Habitat for Humanity.

Award by the BX board of directors, based on an initial review by the Cornerstone
Award Review Committee.
