

2026 Safety Achievement Award

Program Overview

For more than 30 years, The Builders Exchange of Central Ohio has recognized members for proactive safety efforts and exceptional results through the annual BX Safety Awards Program.

The BX Safety Achievement Award is based on your current jobsite performance and accident statistics from 2025, including OSHA incidence rates and your workers' compensation experience modification rate (EMR). National figures from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) are used as benchmarks in the judging process, with separate categories for different North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes. Finalists for the Achievement Award also receive an unannounced site visit from a team of BX judges to verify your safety practices in the field.

Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for a BX Safety Achievement Award, your company must:

- Be a member in good standing of the Builders Exchange of Central Ohio.
- Be directly involved with the commercial construction industry.
- ➤ Have a full-time or part-time designated safety representative on staff.
- Not have had a fatality or caused a fatality in 2023, 2024 or 2025.
- Agree to and undergo an unannounced site visit by a team of BX judges and be performing work in Franklin County or an adjacent county during the judging process. (Service companies and suppliers will not be eligible.)
- ➤ If selected to receive an award, a representative of your company <u>must attend</u> the BX Annual Meeting on November 19, 2026.

Application Requirements

To be considered for an Achievement Award, your company <u>must submit all</u> the following. Your company may be disqualified if all requirements are not submitted.

- 1. Two-page application form.
- 2. One of the following two documents, showing your experience modification rate (EMR):
 - A copy of your company's BWC experience exhibit (also known as notification of rates) from July/August 2025, showing your company's EM%. If you are enrolled in a workers' compensation group, <u>do not submit your **group's** experience exhibit or EM%. You must submit information for your **individual** <u>company</u>. If your company is <u>not</u> in a workers' comp group, you can locate your individual rate at <u>www.bwc.ohio.gov</u>, or by calling the BWC at 614.466.6773. If your company <u>is in</u> a workers' comp group, you can obtain this by contacting your workers' comp third party administrator (TPA) for a copy.</u>
 - OR -
 - ➤ A letter from your workers' comp third-party administrator (TPA) on the TPA's letterhead, indicating your company's EMR for work in Ohio only.
- 3. A copy of your OSHA #300 Log and your 300-A Summary for 2025 for work done in Ohio only. Please white-out or mark through the injured employee names on the 300 Log to protect their privacy.

- ➤ A copy of your company's BWC notification of rates from July/August 2025, or a letter from your TPA stating your <u>individual</u> rate.
- ➤ A copy of your <u>complete</u> OSHA #300 Log and your 300-A Summary for 2025 for work done in Ohio <u>only.</u>

5. Company's primary type of business, with North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code Number:

Your company's "North American Industry Classification System" (NAICS) code is defined by the primary type of work you perform. (Select <u>one</u>.)

Examples of NAICS codes include:

- ➤ NAICS 23622: Non-residential building construction general contractors
- NAICS 23822: Plumbing, heating & air-conditioning (includes sheet metal duct work)
- ➤ NAICS 23832: Painting contractors
- NAICS 23821: Electrical contractors
- NAICS 23814: Masonry contractors
- ➤ NAICS 23833: Flooring contractors
- ➤ NAICS 23815: Glass and glazing contractors
- NAICS 23891: Site preparation contractors
- NAICS 23899: All other specialty trade contractors

7. BWC Experience Modification Percentage (EM%) or Experience Modification Rate (EMR):

The EM% is your experience modification rate, found on your individual company's experience exhibit (also known as notification of rates) from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation. Please use your experience exhibit from 2025. If you are base-rated (instead of merit-rated), you can locate the info. through the BWC at www.bwc.ohio.gov or 614.466.6773.


If you are enrolled in a workers' compensation group, <u>DO NOT USE YOUR GROUP-RATING EMR/EM%</u>. You must use the EMR/EM% of your individual company, so that you are evaluated on your own merit, rather than the EM% of your group. If your firm is in a workers' comp group, call your TPA for a copy of your individual rate for work in Ohio only.

To complete this question on the application form, record your individual EM% exactly as it appears on your BWC experience exhibit from July or August 2025, or as it is reported by your TPA.

8. 2025 Injury/Illness Incidence Rate – <u>Dart Rate</u> (Days Away Restricted Transfer):


Your company's lost workday/restricted workday incidence rate is called your DART rate – for Days Away from work and days of Restricted work activity or job Transfer. To determine this rate, use the following calculation:



In the calculation, 200,000 is the base for 100 full-time workers, working 40 hours per week, 50 weeks per year. All employers use 200,000 in the calculation – regardless of company size.

9. 2025 Injury/Illness Incidence Rate - Total Cases:

Your company's total case incidence rate is your rate of all OSHA-recordable injury and illness cases for the year – including cases with lost workdays, restricted workdays and other recordable cases. To determine this rate, use the following calculation.



In the calculation, 200,000 is the base for 100 full-time workers, working 40 hours per week, 50 weeks per year. All employers use 200,000 in the calculation – regardless of company size.

10. Number of Days Away & Restricted Duty Workdays in 2025:

To determine your number of lost and restricted workdays, add the totals from columns K and L from your company's 2025 OSHA 300 Log.
